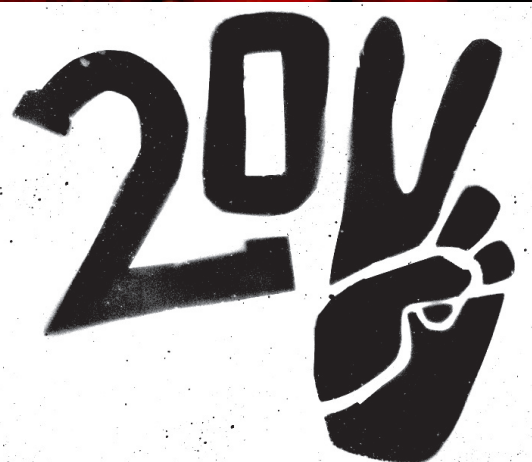


Jean Béliveau on his World Wide Walk for Peace & Children
